CHAPTER 294

An Act to authorize capital outlay funding and to amend and reenact the tenth enactment of Chapter 759 and the tenth enactment of Chapter 769 of the Acts of Assembly of 2016.

[S 1520]

Approved March 23, 2023

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. § 1. That pursuant to § 2.2-2264 of the Code of Virginia, the General Assembly hereby authorizes the Virginia Public Building Authority (VPBA) to issue revenue bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$21,664,500 for the state share of the approved capital costs as determined by the State Board of local and Regional Jails and authorizes any additional amount of VPBA bonds needed to fund other interest costs as provided in §§ 53.1-80 through 53.1-82.2. The General Assembly hereby appropriates the proceeds from any such bonds for the projects listed in this act and the Commonwealth's share of the capital costs shall not exceed the amount listed for each project. Debt service on projects contained in this act shall be provided from appropriations to the Treasury Board. Reimbursements of the state share of construction costs shall be subject to the approval of the Department of Corrections for the final expenditures.

- 2. That the tenth enactment of Chapter 759 of the Acts of Assembly of 2016 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 10. That the appropriations for the capital projects authorized in §§ 1 and 2 of the first enactment of this act are subject to the conditions in § 2-0 F of Chapter 665 of the Acts of Assembly of 2015. In addition, not more than a total aggregate principal amount of \$300 million in debt obligations shall be issued excluding refunding bonds in any fiscal year for such capital projects, provided, however, that if less than a total aggregate principal amount of \$300 million in debt obligations is incurred in any fiscal year for such capital projects, the unused amount may be added to any other subsequent fiscal year. Issuance of debt shall proceed so that the projected average annual debt service on all tax-supported debt over the 10-year horizon shall be in accordance with the guidelines established by the Debt Capacity Advisory Committee. The Six-Year Capital Outlay Plan Advisory Committee shall establish procedures to ensure compliance with the annual issuance limits and shall meet at least quarterly four times annually to review project progress. The Auditor of Public Accounts shall issue a report annually to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Delegates, the President pro tempore of the Senate, and the Chairmen of the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance and Appropriations, regarding the adherence to the annual issuance limits.

Background:

The Board initiated a Community Based Corrections Plan, CBCP, to determine the current and future needs of the facility which are necessary to fulfill its mission.

The results of the study have indicated that facility needs relatively substantial renovations of the 1974 portion of the jail to include but not limited to electrical systems, HVAC, flooring, plumbing, security systems, ADA compliance.

The report also indicated reconfiguring the physical infrastructure to accommodate outdoor recreation, a more conducive family, friends and professional visitation area, a purpose designed housing area for inmates with special housing needs, improvements to inmate housing areas as well as improvements to staff areas.

The General Assembly has approved the Jail's request for 25% reimbursement of all eligible costs associated with the project.

Current Situation:

On September 1, 2023, the Jail has issued a Request for Proposal, RFP, for architecture and engineering, A&E, services. The request seeks a firm to coordinate with community members, jail staff and other pertinent entities and individuals to propose a design that meet the needs identified in the CBCP study. The intent is to identify the winning A&E firm in early November. Only with the Board Authority approval at its December Board meeting will a contract with the A&E firm be finalized.

Once the cost for A&E services is determined by the above RFP process, Sans Anderson, the Board Authority's bond counsel, will issue an RFP for interim-financing. This RFP expected to be issued in November with terms presented at the December Board Authority meeting. Only with the approval of the Board Authority will debt be issued for the purpose of financing the design process.

At the Board's direction, the Superintendent and pertinent consultants will present a resolution to all three jurisdictions' governing bodies to allow the Jail Board Authority to issue interim and permanent debt necessary to fund the project. An estimated cost of interim-financing will be included in the

resolution as well as the estimated share for each jurisdiction.

- 2) Albemarle County Board of Supervisors at noon on November 15, 2023
- 3) Nelson County Board of Supervisors at 2:00pm on November 16, 2023

If all three jurisdictions approve the resolution, the Superintendent and financial consultants will present a resolution to the Board Authority to approve the interim-financing terms as determined by the above financing RFP.

If the Board Authority reaffirms its intent to proceed with the design process, The Superintendent will present three notices of intent to proceed to the Board.


- 1) The terms, debt share and costs of the interim financing.

If affirmed by the Board Authority, the design process will begin in early 2024.
